Pre-bridge staking

Stake your KLX now to earn reward before the bridge

Pre-bridge staking of KLX will help build and secure the Kalima Network.

The longer the tokens are staked, the bigger the reward will be, with a maximum return of 10% if you hold your tokens until the Bridge.

The Bridge corresponds to the launch of the Kalima Main net and the swap from the ERC20 KLX token to the native KLX token. It is planned for February 2024

The rewards will be distributed monthly for 12 months from the day of the brige.

How to stake your KLX step by step:

Staking your KLX is easy and takes 3 steps, you keep full control of your tokens, they will not be locked in any way but remember that Tokens that aren't staked before the bridge will not bring any reward.

Have KLX on Bitmart or on a custodial Wallet



2. Withdraw your KLX from Bitmart and put them on chain, on your wallet


To stake your KLX, you first have to withdraw them from Bitmart and put them on chain on the Polygon Network.

Withdraw from Bitmart:


On Bitmart click on « Assets » and then « Spot »




You will see your KLX Balance here.




Click then on « Withdraw » and « Send via a crypto Network »




Enter here your Polygon Adresse




If you are using Metamask your Polygon adresse can be found here: Make sure you are using the Polygon Mainnet on Metamask



Copy this adress and paste it on Bitmart, enter the Amount of KLX you want to send to your wallet to stake them and click on Withdraw.



You KLX are now sent to your Polygon adress (here we are using Metamask) you can see them here on Metamask :



If you don't see your KLX make sure you have imported the KLX contract:

3. Stake your KLX

Everything is now ready and you can stake your KLX.

Pre-bridge staking

Staking ERC20 tokens will help build and secure the Kalima Network, creating a robust staking pool ahead of the launch of the Kalima MainChain.

Between February 2nd, 2023 and the date of the bridge – scheduled for Q1 2024 – KLX holders will be able to stake their tokens in the "Pre-Bridge staking" program.

The longer the tokens are staked, the bigger the reward will be, with a maximum return of 10%, for a maximum staking period, i.e. from February 2nd to the day of the launch of the bridge.

The rewards will be distributed monthly for 12 months from the bridge, for the launch of the Kalima MainChain and the swap of the KLX ERC20 to the native KLX.

Tokens that aren't staked before the bridge will not bring any reward.

A few days before the bridge, a snapshot of the KLX staked on the Polygon network will be made, in order to freeze all the addresses that have saked KLX. The addresses present at the time of the Snapshot (all the addresses declared in staking and the amount of KLX stake on each address, which will determine the amount of rewards for each staker.

How to participate in pre-bridge staking?

To participate in the pre-bridge staking, a KLX holder will simply have to declare "a staking address" on the Kalima website. A staking address is a polygon address holding ERC20 KLX.


To declare the staking address you will simply have to enter your polygon address here.

Any token held at the time of the bridge will be considered as staked.

Tokens that aren't staked before the bridge will not bring any reward.

Be careful, if you declare a staking address on Kalima, any token transferred to another address will no longer count as staked tokens when calculating rewards. In other words, if you declare a staking address on Kalima, only the tokens present on this address will be taken into account when distributing your reward.
